Actions 23/24/01	APPROVAL OF MINUTES
	It was RESOLVED that the minutes of the meeting held on 17th November 2022

23/24/02 STAFFING ISSUES

The Clerk updated the meeting on his recent health issues and said that although not 100% fit, is now working normally and has arranged a number of burials and headstones in the last couple of weeks.

He said that our Caretaker, John, is still hampered by the after effects of his recent heart operation and is limited in his abilities. Sue Holmes is filling in where needed.

The Chair also advised the meeting that he has his own health issues and will keep the Committee informed on any new developments.

23/24/03 BANK BALANCE UPDATE

The Clerk said we have £40,300 in the Bank, after all current bills have been paid.

23/24/04 REVIEW OF 2022/23 BUDGET

The Clerk had previously circulated details of the Budget Outcome for 2022/23 The Clerk said that we finished £10,432 over Budget for expenditure and £906 under budget for Income. The Clerk reported several points of note in the results. Our expenditure was higher than Budgeted due to the installation of solar panels and the

cutting down of two dead and dangerous trees in the Lodge garden. A new fence then had to be erected for security reasons.

Income was lower due to a lower number of burials last year. The Final Budget report is attached as (**Appendix A.**)

23/24/05 APPROVAL OF 2022/23 ACCOUNTS

Previously, the Clerk had circulated copies of the 2022/23 Accounts to Members. After discussion, it was agreed that the Accounts be approved. This was proposed by Cllr. C Brennan and seconded by Cllr. Peterson.

23/24/06 APPROVAL OF GOVERNANCE STATEMENTS

The Clerk read out the Governance Statements. The answer to all the questions were "yes" and these were approved by the Committee, having been proposed by Cllr A Palmer and seconded by Cllr. Brennan, and the Chairman duly signed them the next day.

23/24/07 APPROVAL OF ACCOUNTING STATEMENTS

Previously, the Clerk had circulated the 2022/23 Accounting Statements to Members After discussion, these were approved by the Committee, having been proposed by Cllr. H Palmer and seconded by Cllr. Brennan and the Chairman duly signed them the next day.

MAINTENANCE ISSUES 23/24/10 The Clerk said that there were no issues at the moment. We have asked Edwin to spray the Box trees as they are suffering from die-back because of Box Moth.

APPROVAL OF RISK ASSESSMENT 23/24/11 The Clerk had already circulated the 2023/24 Risk Assessment to Councillors. After a brief discussion, it was unanimously approved. 23/24/12 CHEQUES FOR AUTHORISATION AND APPROVAL Cheques for Authorisation and Payment were presented by the Clerk.
